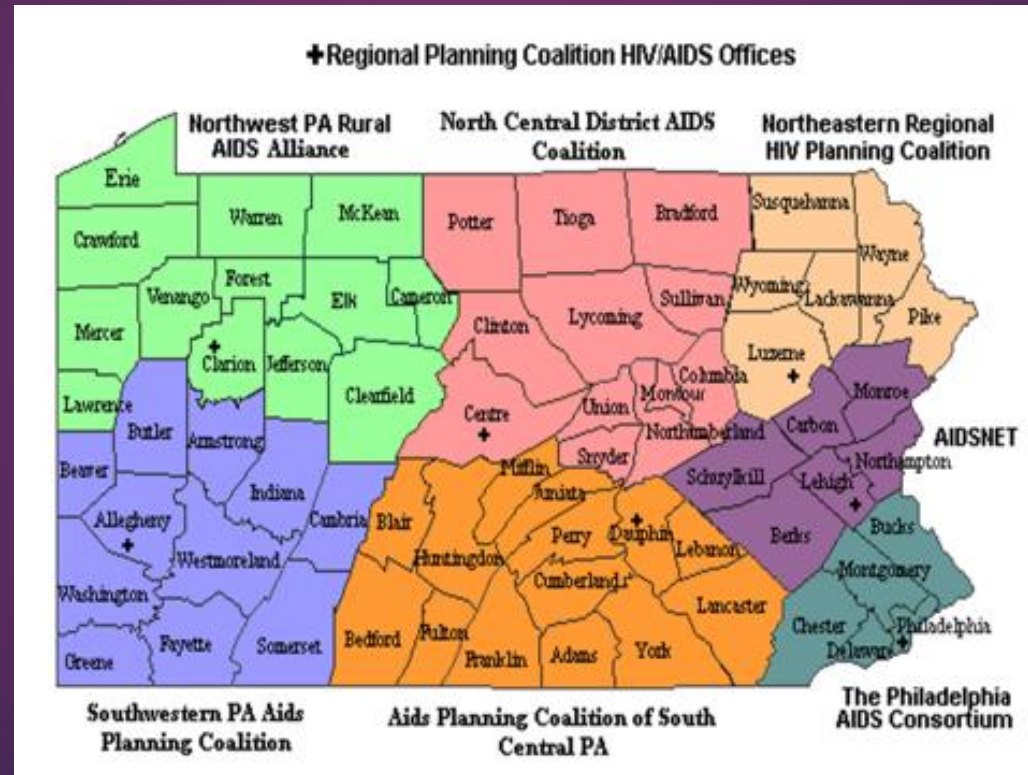

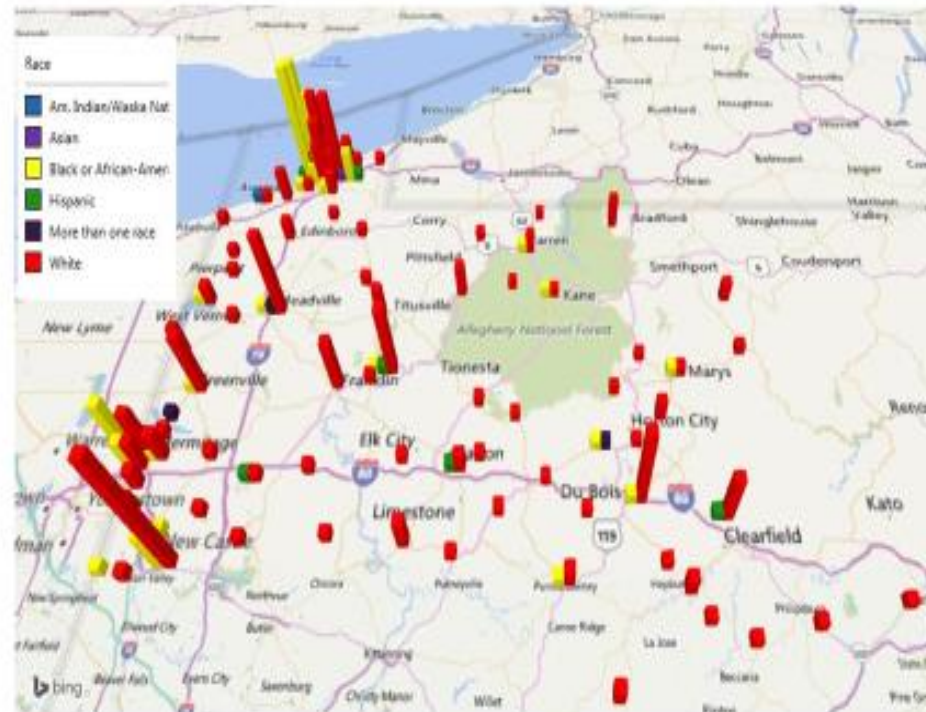
The AIDS Alliance
